EU Ambassador to the Republic of South Africa

Sandra Kramer is the European Union's Ambassador to South Africa since August 2022. She had previously been Africa Director at the European Commission's Directorate-General for International Partnerships.

Ambassador Kramer joined the European Commission in 1995 in the Directorate-General for External Relations. She served as Trade Counsellor at the EU Delegation to Indonesia and as Head of Economic Co-operation at the EU Delegation to India.

Ambassador Kramer served assistant to the European as Chief Spokesperson and assistant to Commission's the Deputy Director-General in the Directorate-General for Enterprise & Industry. She was nominated to Head of the Communication Unit of DG Enterprise & Industry in 2007.

From 2010 to 2014, Ambassador Kramer was Head of Unit at the Directorate-General for Justice before joining the Cabinet of President Juncker as Director of Coordination and Administration with key responsibilities on Budget and Human Resources.

Ambassador Kramer holds a Masters degree in Modern Literature from the University of Groningen, as well as a Masters degree in Economics and International Relations from Johns Hopkins University, School of Advanced International Studies, Bologna and Washington DC.
